The Superintendent shall base his decision on any early readmission, upon discussion with the school administration, on whether the student has participated successfully in the alternative educational program. Any early readmission shall be on a probationary basis, and any new misconduct that would result in a suspension or expulsion will cause the remaining portion of this expulsion to be imposed (in addition to any discipline for such misconduct).
