The student may apply to the Superintendent for early readmission into school upon successful completion of the tutoring program provided by the Rocky Hill Board of Education. The Superintendent shall base his decision on an early readmission on whether the student has participated successfully in the alternative educational program. Any early readmission shall be on a probationary basis for a period of 180 days, and any new misconduct that would result in a suspension or expulsion will cause the remaining portion of this expulsion to be imposed (in addition to any discipline for such misconduct). Unanimous vote in favor by the Board of Education.
