A complete application must include the following documents in the envelope:

- Student Information Cover Sheet (next page)
- Essay (see requirements below)
- Resume (as it relates to leadership)
- Unofficial Transcript (provided by your guidance counselor)
- Copy of a Photo I.D. (e.g. license, passport, high school I.D.)

## LEADERSHIP ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

Please include an **800-1,000** word, typed essay, which addresses the following prompts:

- Reflect on your experiences as a leader. Identify and explain how these personal experiences demonstrate your leadership skills.
- Explain why you want to participate in the Leadership Academy.

In addition, address at least one of the following questions in your essay:

- What will you bring to the Leadership Academy?
- What in your mind are the qualities of a good leader?
- Identify a leader who has significantly influenced you. How has this person inspired you?



**Essays may not exceed 1,000 words.**
